



Process and content


An acceleration programme with 5 objectives



Tailor-made program for each selected organisation




- 360° diagnosis
- Specific analysis and support on identified challenges : governance/strategy, HR/management, finance, purchas ing/supply, R&D, production and quality, logistics/distribution, sales/marketing, digitalisation
- Individual and collective training and coaching (remotely by FR experts)
- Mentoring by French company of the same field to share on potential innovation or transformation
- Individual follow-up by Farm'Innov project Officer to support the companies and help them being committed to the programme




- Discovery and application missions in France
- Meetings with entrepreneurs, visits to sites and companies
- Sharing workshop and feedback report at the end of the assignment
- Financial participation : The cost (flight, accommodation, catering costs, and transport during the week of immersion visits) will be financed by Farm'Innov.
- 7 days in France (1 participant per organisation)
- Once in February 2025 and the other in September 2025


